

Gauber Bunk Barn & Den Covid -19 Update

Please see additions to our existing Terms and Conditions below. These will be subject to change as government restrictions, guidelines and legislation are revised.

-From the 14th September 2020 (and until further notice) due to government legislation the bunk barn will be available for sole use only for a maximum of 6 people from different households or 1 single household (including a social bubble).

-A minimum 2 night stay will apply in the bunk barn. Due to reduced occupancy we have revised our prices.

Prices start from £150 per night for up to 6 people. Where a single household exceeds 6 people additional guests are charged £21pppn.

The basic price includes fitted sheets, pillows and a starter pack of logs/kindling. Duvets and towels are available to hire.

-From the 14th September 2020 (and until further notice) The Den will be available for up to 4 people from different households.

A minimum 2 night stay will apply in The Den on Friday and Saturday nights.

From Sunday to Thursday The Den will be available for single night bookings. Our normal pricing will apply.

-For stays within the next 6 months deposit payments are not being taken.

Balance payments will be due 1 week prior to your stay. If you do need to cancel we ask that you give us as much notice as possible.

For stays booked 6 months in advance a deposit of 25% will be required. Balance payments will be due 6 weeks prior to your stay.

-All bookings are subject to local and national lockdown guidelines and restrictions.

We cannot accept bookings from guests in quarantine.

-Please only visit if you and members of your group are well and are not self isolating. If you are not able to travel please give us as much notice as possible.

-If any of your party show signs of having the virus please notify us immediately.

The person must contact www.nhs.uk or call NHS 111 and arrange to be tested as a matter of urgency. The result must be shown to us. If positive you will need to leave if any member of your party can drive you.

If that's not possible and you have to self-isolate here then you will have to pay for your extended stay and for any bookings cancelled as a result.

- We have been asked to assist NHS Test and Trace by keeping a record of guests names and telephone details of 21 days. If you do not wish for your details to be shared for Test and Trace purposes you can opt out. Please inform us of your preference.

-Additional visitors to the barn and Den will not be permitted during your stay.

- We recommend regular hand washing at all times during your stay.

-Hand sanitiser will be available(please do not remove from either property).

- Please frequently change hand towels, if you need more please ask.

-The barn and Den will have been deep cleaned as per guidelines prior to your stay. Cleaning products will be available for guests to use during your stay(please do not remove from either property).

-Guests staying in the barn, please wash all cutlery, crockery, glasses, pots, pans and dishes in the dishwasher, dishwasher tablets will be provided.

In The Den please wash all crockery and cutlery etc well in hot soapy water.

-We've had to remove all books and information leaflets from the barn. If you require any information about places of interest, walks etc please ask.

-For the time being we've had to remove our visitors book. If you wish to leave a review please go to our pages on Trip Advisor, Facebook or Google, thank you.

-These amendments are in addition to our standard terms and conditions.

-We live on-site and will be able to help with any queries at a social distance.
