

Gauber Bunk Barn & Den
Information about your stay

-Our water supply comes from a nearby borehole. The water is tested annually by Craven District Council and is safe to drink. If you would prefer to drink bottled water we do have bottles available for purchase.

Our water passes through a UV filtration system. At times, (usually after heavy rainfall) the filters can become blocked and cause a drop in water pressure. Please let us know as soon as possible if you notice a drop in water pressure and we will change the filter, it takes 2 minutes!

- A septic tank collects waste from the barn and Den. Please do not put any products other than toilet paper down the toilet.

-Please note that some of the stairs in the barn are uneven and some of the doorways are quite low.

- The Den has an alternating tread staircase up to the bed deck on the mezzanine floor. Please note that there is reduced head height in the bed deck area.

-All the bunk beds are designed to sleep adults and children, however the top bunks are not suitable for children under the age of 6 years. The maximum weight for each bunk bed is 17 stones.

-We provide a starter pack of logs/kindling and coal. Further logs etc.. are available at extra cost, please ask.

- A simple breakfast of cereal, toast and hot drinks can be provided for an additional charge. Please order in advance.

-Please remember to bring sleeping bags and towels if you have not chosen to hire duvets and towels. Fitted sheets, pillows and pillowcases are provided (only applies in the bunk barn).

- Bed linen and towels are included in the price when booking The Den.

-We do have a drying room/bike store for guest use.

-We have an area of free parking outside the barn and Den.

-There are 2 pubs nearby. They become very busy particularly at weekends. We strongly recommend you book a table if you wish to eat at any of our local pubs. Please see their websites for sample menus.

The nearest pub is the Station Inn, Ribbleshead which is a 15 min walk from Gauber.

-There are also a number of restaurants and pubs in Ingleton (15 min drive from Gauber).

The barn has a fully equipped kitchen if you would prefer to bring your own food to prepare. For the summer months we have a BBQ available for use in the garden to the rear of the barn(charcoal is not provided).

- The Den has basic cooking facilities which include a small worktop oven with double hob,microwave,,kettle and toaster. The Den has a small fridge with small icebox.

-Gauber Bunk Barn & Den are in a rural location. The nearest shops can be found in Ingleton(15 min drive from Gauber). There are a number of small shops including a Co-op, pharmacy, newsagent, outdoor shop and a number of restaurants, pubs and takeaways (some offer a delivery service).

- We do provide a grocery service which we find is particularly helpful for our Dales Way guests. Please provide a list of items you require a couple of days prior to your stay and we will ensure the items are in the barn for when you arrive. Payment for these items can be made on departure.

-Midges!! You may find it useful to bring a repellent with you to use when you are out and about in the Dales during the summer months.

-The Settle-Carlisle railway reopened in March 2017. Please go to www.uksteamtours for details of steam trains running on the line. It's quite an impressive sight to see a steam train cross the Ribbleshead Viaduct!
